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Currently, 64.0% of the 29,979 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 25.9%, renter occupied; and 10.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 29,588 housing units in the area and 11.2% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.31%. Median home value in the area is \$322,989, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.14% annually to \$395,693.
